From December 2001 through to July 2002, Mac was seconded to the 2002 Kananaskis G-8 summit, training approximately 6,500 Canadian and international police, military and security officials on Canadian laws pertaining to: powers of arrest, warrantless search and seizure, unlawful assembly, terrorism response, and protection of international diplomats. He also was involved in the planning for a wide variety of legal responses to potential incident scenarios.		
Mac also provided training on the role of Expert Witnesses to ITRAC (Integrated Threat and Risk Assessment Centre) and Calgary Police Service in the context of Domestic Violence prosecutions, and to CATAP (Canadian Association of Threat Assessment Professionals) in the context of workplace safety.
